

MOVE UP FORM

As per Section 13, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order or otherwise at the secretary's or Judges discretion.

FIRST - PLEASE READ THE MOVEUP SECTION IN THIS PREMIUM LIST

EMAILED MOVEUPS: When emailing a moveup to us please just give the following information. Owner Name. Dog Call Name, Move up from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW)

NOVICE MOVEUPS: Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std **OR** JWW) must be moved to the Nov B Class (Std **and** JWW) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Nov A to Nov B. If the trial has already reached the closing date on the day the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered. The dog can also be moved up a level (Nov to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

Before the trial Move ups may be made prior to the moveup deadline via email to NJHorse@aol.com, via facsimile transmission to 856-234-6117 or in writing to Dottie Allen, 25 Beth Drive, Moorestown, NJ 08057. Verbal move ups will not be accepted.

Move ups for this Tuesday trial are due in writing by 6PM on the Tuesday that is 7 days prior to the trial. Move Ups for March 6th are due by 6PM on February 28th. Move Ups for March 7th will be accepted at the March 6th trial.

Awarded to the winner of the trial that is designated as the National Specialty. The Trophy is an engraved silver bowl on a wooden base. The winner receives a similar trophy plaque. The High in Agility Trial Challenge Trophy is offered by Kathy Marshall and the Hound Pack.

PBGVCA National Specialty Challenge Trophies

For permanent possession: a) a trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows; and b) the owner must be a member in good standing of the PBGVCA, and must have been a member during each of these three wins.

Highest Scoring Dog in Trial is awarded on the basis of highest score which must be 100. If there is a tie for the highest score, then the dog with the most yards per second prevails.

Motor Homes / trailers: Parking available at the host hotel, but you may not stay in it overnight. No hookups or electricity, no charge. Please inform the hotel that you are bringing an RV when you make your reservation

Nearby camping: RV park 2 1/2 miles from the agility trial: Meridian RV Resort, Apache Junction, AZ. The phone number is 480-474-8900. They have a 2 dog limit but said if someone phones, they are open to discuss an exception.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. All classes will be held outdoors. The size of the rings will be approximately 85' x 95'.
2. **THIS TRIAL IS LIMITED TO PBGVs.**
3. **DOGS PARTICIPATING** must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration or ILP registration. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
4. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate. Refund of entry fees will be made for bitches in season after the closing of entries only with a veterinarian's certification of the bitch being in season and there will be a \$5.00 secretarial fee per trial deducted from the refund. Vet certificates must be received before the end of the day of the trial.
5. **REFUNDS:** There shall be **no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are injured, absent, or dismissed from competition**, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only.
6. Move ups deadline for trials is Tuesday, February 28 at 6PM, except that we will accept move ups for the March 7th trial at the March 6th trial. Please email information to NJHorse@aol.com or fax to 856-234-1081.
7. The regulations for Agility Trial are available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Canterview Dr., Raleigh, NC 2760. These trials will be held under these rules. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the rules and regulations.
8. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
9. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
10. Check with your own vet for any health certificates that might be required for traveling to the National Specialty site regarding crossing state lines, etc.
11. We will be using electronic timing equipment

Declining of Entries: The PBGVCA, Inc. may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

Classes offered for Standard and JWW.
There are no FAST classes offered at this trial
Time to Beat will be offered both days
Regular - Novice A & B, Open, Exc A & B
Preferred - Novice, Open, Exc A & B

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height

Preferred The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	REGULAR	PREFERRED
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches

MEASURING

If you have never been measured for a permanent AKC jump height card, you can still enter any AKC Agility Trial. All jump heights **MUST** be measured unless you have a valid height card. If you do have a permanent jump height card from the AKC, you must send in a copy with your entry form

If there is no official measurer at the trial, you will be measured by the judge for that trial only.

If your dog measures lower at the trial, you cannot move your dog down in jump height for that trial unless it is entered in the Preferred class. If your dog measures higher than the class you originally entered, you must notify the trial secretary and show your dog in the higher jump height for that trial and subsequent shows.

Weave poles will be 24" distance from pole to pole

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lesser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, and Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
