There is a \$4.00 per entry fee charge for credit card payments. FAX entries that are received incomplete or unable to read will not be accepted. **Make All Checks and Money Orders PAYABLE TO Lea Plaut.** CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing no refunds of \$4.00 and under will be made. There is a \$2.00 fee for any entry cancellations.

**A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and a Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry, \$3.00 Rally fee** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards,** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**During the hours of judging** owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

**The club, its secretaries or their employees** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

**Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**Trophies and Prizes** will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**Dogs which according** to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

**Junior Handlers** who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**Please DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, immediate action will be taken and Law Enforcement will be contacted. Violators may be reported to the Show Committee for disciplinary action. all persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the show giving clubs or their members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. **THIS IS A SELF CLEANING SHOW, PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.**

**THE SHOW COMMITTEE HAS DESIGNATED THE HOTEL GROUNDS AS THE SHOW SITE.**

An Event Committee Hearing may be held to address any hotel complaint, including bathing of dogs in the rooms, failure to clean up after your dog and any destruction of hotel property. The rules agreed to between the hotel and the PBGVCA are:

**Don't leave your dogs alone loose in the room, ever.**

- All dogs must be crated whenever you are not in the room. Ex-pens are not to be used in the rooms. Crates must have a plastic drop cloth spread beneath them. A drop cloth can be found in the club hospitality bag you receive at check-in. More will be available at the hospitality table.
- Do NOT use the hotel towels for anything related to the dogs. Dogs are not to be bathed or groomed in the hotel room. A grooming area is available near the show ring. Booster Bath tubs will be available outside the Ballroom from Wednesday afternoon on for bathing dogs
- Leftover dog food should be disposed of in a plastic bag or in a wastebasket that has been lined with a plastic bag. Drains which are clogged by dog hair or dog food shall be considered "damage".
- Hotel staff will collect the bedspreads from your rooms shortly after check-in. If this has not occurred within a few hours of your arrival, please call housekeeping and request that it be done. If you allow your dogs on the furniture, please cover it first with **YOUR** towel, bedspread, blanket, etc., not with the hotel's linens.
- Exercise your dogs only in the marked areas, and **clean up after your dog**. Trash bins and a supply of plastic bags will be available near the designated walking areas. Do not allow your male to urinate on the shrubbery or flowerbeds. If your dog has an accident in the hotel, mark the spot and notify housekeeping immediately before the stain has a chance to set.
- No dogs allowed in the swimming pool, bar or restaurant areas.
- We are not the only guests in this hotel. Do not allow your dogs to bark to an extent it annoys the other guests, especially late at night or early in the morning. If your dogs tend to get vocal when left alone, take measures to ensure that they don't cause a nuisance in your absence: e.g. leave a TV on for company, have a friend pop in and out to check on them or better yet, leave them with a friend, leave in the club's "dog-sitting" room, leave them in your vehicle, etc.
- If your dog damages anything, 'fess up to it" and be prepared to pay the charges.

**Veteran Classes** - Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 7 years old and over.

**Hunt Class** will be for dogs who have passed the Hunting Instinct Test and/or been awarded a leg at a PBGVCA sponsored hunt. The class will be judged by how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

**Stud Dog Class** - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. **\$30.00 entry fee.**

**Brood Bitch Class** - Will be for Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. **\$30.00 entry fee.**

**Brace Class** - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry (Two, identical ownership and will require **\$30.00** entry fee for the Brace as a Unit.). If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", fee is \$15.00 per dog. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2", etc.

**Team Class** - The Team class is for four dogs of the same breed having identical ownership. The dogs comprising the team must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a team is entered in another class and entered as part of a team, specify "Team Class" in Additional Classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Team Class Only" (**\$30.00 entry fee for Team Class only - per dog**) in the Dog Show Class section of the form. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Team Class". If more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be so designated "Team No. 1, Team No. 2", etc.

**Pack Class (Nat. Specialty Only)** - The pack consists of an entry of at least 6 dogs that are all bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. The entry is made in the name of the kennel represented by the dogs as well as the exhibitor's name(s). The dogs are brought in the ring by up to 2 handlers, one of which *must* be the named exhibitor. The dogs will be judged on a point system with 120 being the maximum. Half the points (60) are allotted for how well the pack corresponds to breed type, and the other half (60) are allotted on size (30) and color (30) of the whole. The dogs are judged as a pack rather than as individuals; since they are judged on type, size and color as a whole, they are not gaited. All dogs judged in the pack class must be entered in the regular classes. The judges shall choose one winner. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Pack MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Pack Class". If more than one Pack is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Pack must be so designated "Pack No. 1, Pack No. 2", etc. **Entry Fee is \$30.00 per Pack.**

**Three Generation Pedigree Class** - Each entry will consist of 3 specified PBGV's, dogs and/or bitches from 3 different generations, e.g. sire-daughter-grandson, in any combination as long as they are direct descendants. The 3 generations need not be consecutive. All 3 dogs must be bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. All three will be listed in the catalog. The entry is judged as a unit, with no one outstanding individual outweighing the quality of the others. All are judged on how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard, quality and consistency. The quality of each generation should meet or exceed that of the previous generation. The judge shall choose one winner. **Entry Fee \$30.00 per Unit. National Only.**

**Award of Merit (Regional & National)** -After Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best Opposite Sex, Select Dog & Bitch are judged, the remaining dogs in the ring will stay (including Best of Opposite Sex, Winners Dog & Winners Bitch,) for the judge to award Awards of Merit to no more than 10% of the Best of Breed entry. Each dog will receive a Rosette.

**Obedience and Rally Trial Classes - Qualifying Score Required for all Prizes in Regular Classes.** 'Dog' means either sex. A dark green rosette will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying Score. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate. Refund of entry fees will be made for bitches in season after the closing of entries only with a veterinarian's certification of the bitch being in season and there will a \$10.00 secretarial fee per trial deducted from the refund. (Regional & National)
